I would like to kindly inquire if it would be possible to submit my questions for inclusion, as the tender has been postponed to May 21st and the official list of inquiries has not been published yet. I would greatly appreciate it if you could consider the following inquiries:

Inquiries:

1. Who will be responsible for the allocation of the 3,000 government employees to be trained under this program?

The Ministry of Digital Economy and Entrepreneurship (MoDEE) will be responsible for identifying the government entities whose employees will participate in the training program and by only facilitate communication with these entities. However, the winning bidder will be responsible for following up with the selected entities to ensure the attendance of employees at the workshops and training sessions, and for delivering the training to 3,000 government employees

2. Are there any defined success criteria or performance indicators for the trained employees?

As mentioned in the RFP document, The project's success will be measured by achieving the following overall targets:

- Training 3,000 government employees through a series of Awareness Workshops in the field of Artificial Intelligence, targeting employees from no less than 35 to 40 government entities.
- Conducting 30 workshops for leadership-level participants across 30 government entities, focusing on Strategic Leadership in the field of AI for public sector leadership and decision-makers.
- Providing intensive Technical AI training for 20 government employees from different entities, consisting of no less than 100 training hours.
- Conducting Pre- and post-assessment questionnaires to measure knowledge gained during the training for Awareness workshop and technical AI training

3. Regarding the Strategic Leadership Workshops, the RFP specifies organizing 30 workshops within 30 government entities. Is there a specific number of participants to be trained in each workshop, or an overall number of participants?

As mentioned in the RFP document the actual number of participants for each Leader workshop depends on the government entities' size and requirements. These workshops are specifically targeted the Minister, Secretary General, Directors, high-level managers, and their equivalents within each entity. (The main requirement is to conduct

30 leader workshops for 30 different government entities, regardless of the total number of participants per session.

4. Should the financial proposal be submitted as a separate document from the technical proposal?

Yes, As mentioned in the RFP document, Proposals should be submitted in a well-sealed and wrapped envelope clearly marked, as follows: "Raising the Awareness of AI for Public Employees". Technical Proposal, Financial Proposal

5. Concerning the workshop content and training materials — are these open for suggestions and customization by the bidder, or is the bidder required to strictly follow the content outlined in the RFP?

The winning bidder is required to follow the content outlined in the RFP documents. However, we are open to receiving additional suggestions and recommendations for enhancing the workshop content and training materials, as long as they align with the overall objectives and goals of the program.
